When I breathe deeply I begin to hear the heavenly song. I actually hear harmony. Many voices in agreement, in beauty proclaiming a never-ending song. I sense there is a center to my life. Something is holding me together. As I become calm peace surrounds me. In that peace the answer comes.

Yet somehow their beauty tells us there is a creator who uses all things for his good purpose.

Is 11:10

10 In that day the Root of Jesse will stand as a banner for the peoples; the nations will rally to him, and his place of rest will be glorious. NIV

Recently I awoke from a dream. I heard a voice say, "Eph 3 9."

Ephesians 3:8-10

Josh 24:27

## 7. HOLINESS-

Mt. 10 16

Behold I send you out as sheep in the midst of wolves. Therefore be wise as a serpent and innocent as a dove

Wisdom and innocence seem to be opposites. Wisdom is associated with the serpent, the one in the garden. Innocence is usually associated with a child. Isa 11:6-9

The calf and the young lion and the fatling together;

7 The cow and the bear shall graze;  
Their young ones shall lie down together;  
And the lion shall eat straw like the ox.  
8 The nursing child shall play by the cobra's hole,  
And the weaned child shall put his hand in the viper's den.  
9 They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain,  
For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD  
As the waters cover the sea. NKJV

Here we see the child playing by the cobra's hole. Innocence and wisdom exist together in the restored earth.

Deut 23:14

14 For the LORD your God walks in the midst of your camp, to deliver you and give your enemies over to you; therefore your camp shall be holy, that He may see no unclean thing among you, and turn away from you. NKJV

After Adam and Eve ate of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil they knew they were naked. They sensed they were no longer free. They were unclean. They put on fig leaves to cover themselves. Their consciences were clouded. Their vision blurred. Instead of Eden they had chosen the way of darkness. Instead of life

they had chosen death. Thinking themselves wise they had become fools. Instead of innocence they were guilty.

**Rom 1:22-25**

22 Professing to be wise, they became fools, 23 and changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man — and birds and four-footed animals and creeping things.

24 Therefore God also gave them up to uncleanness, in the lusts of their hearts, to dishonor their bodies among themselves, 25 who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen. NKJV

In our arrogance we begin worshipping created things instead of the creator. As a parent I become grieved when I see my children giving their time and energy to the creation more than the creator. It can be as simple as getting lost in media world. Some of us go so far as to worship beings who claim to be the creator who promise us false Eden's when in reality they take us downward to deception, depression and death. Many of us betray our own hearts and like Cain become lost and angry people searching for pleasure in the earth but denying the author of creation.

There are many books out to tell us how to be natural. They claim we can create an Eden like life by right eating, bathing, exercise etc. They have a right idea. We are to be sensible about how we live. If we follow our desire to subdue the earth beginning with our own bodies we are on the right track. However, we often substitute these disciplines for spending time with the master gardener, God himself. He will teach us how to live, how to subdue, how to possess what we inherit by faith in Christ. He has given us great and precious promises, covenant promises. Through faith in Gods word to us we inherit the earth.

**Matt 5:5**

5 Blessed are the meek,  
For they shall inherit the earth.

**Gal 5 : 1**

**It is for freedom Christ has set us free be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.**

There was a serpent in the garden. He is the father of lies, the one who leads into bondage. Eden dwellers must love the blood bought freedom of the cross enough

to turn away from the lying serpent. Eden demands faithfulness, truth, courage, hope, and love. The call of the Kingdom of God is the call to Eden.

Jesus says,
