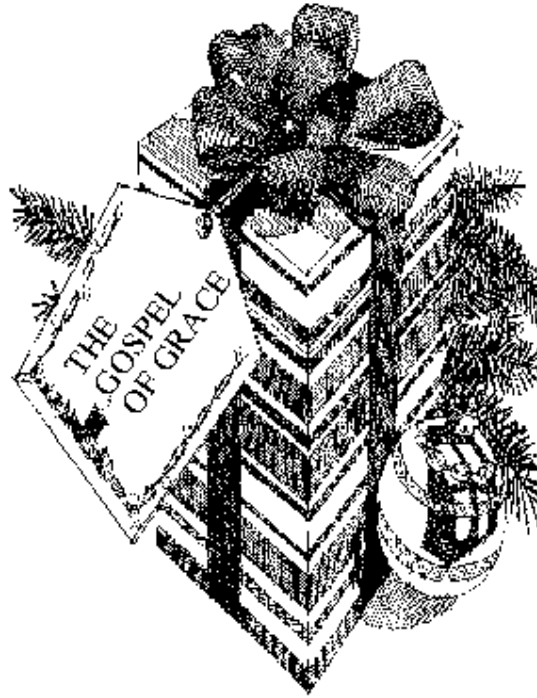

GRACE-CHARIS
GIFTS OF GRACE-CHARISMA

1. The unmerited favor and love of God toward man in Christ
2. Spiritual excellence and virtue
3. Divine sanctifying, regenerating, and preserving influence
4. The divine influence upon the heart and its reflection in the life
5. The mercy of God as distinguished from His justice, also any benefits his mercy imparts; divine love or pardon
6. A state of acceptance with God; enjoyment of the divine favor called more fully "state of grace"
7. A dispensation
8. To dignify or raise by an act of favor; to honor
9. The power and ability to perform the will of God
10. Granting temporary exemption from a penalty. A reprieve i.e. "a years grace"

THE GRACE UPON THE MESSIAH

1. Lk. 2:40- The grace of God was upon Him
 - a. Ps. 45:2- Grace is poured upon (through) your lips

2. Jn. 1:14-16 (read 9-13 Born of God)
 - a. "Full of grace and truth" vs. 14
 - b. Fullness- "grace upon grace" vs. 16
 - c. Law by Moses, grace and truth were realized through Jesus Christ" vs. 17
 - 1) 2 Tim. 2:1- "Be strong in the grace"

3. Heb. 2:9 "He, by the grace of God, should taste death for every man"

4. Heb. 12:2 " fixing our eyes upon Jesus, the author and finisher (perfecter) of our faith
 - a. Jn. 6:40- "beholds the Son and believes"

 - a. Acts 15:7-21 (11)"But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall all be saved in the same manner as they."
 1. Giving them the Holy Spirit-8
 2. Purifying their hearts by faith-9
 3. . . .test God by putting a yoke(bondage)-10
 4. The tabernacle of David, a picture of grace-16&17
 5. Simple requirements-20
 - b. The gospel for the uncircumcised- Gal.1:7-16
 1. Peter's fear-11-16
2. 2 Cor.11:2-4 " For I am jealous for you with godly jealousy. For I have betrothed you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ. But I fear as the serpent beguiled Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity and purity of devotion to Christ. For if he who comes preaches another Jesus whom we have not preached, or if you receive a different spirit which you have not received, or a different gospel which you have not accepted. . . ."
3. Eph.3:2-" the dispensation of **grace** which was given to me "
 - a. vs.3-12
 - b. 1Pet.4:10-" good stewards of the manifold **grace** of God"
4. Heb.12:14-15 " Pursue peace with all men and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord: looking diligently lest anyone fall short of the **grace of God**; lest any root of bitterness springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled"
5. Heb.12:28- "Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have **grace**, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. For our God is a consuming fire."

c. "The Spirit who dwells in us yearns jealously" -vs.5

d. "He gives more grace." -vs.6

e. "God resists the proud but gives grace to the humble"

1) Vines- " If those who are acting so flagrantly, as if it were so, will listen to the scriptures instead of letting it speak in vain and will act so that the Holy Spirit may have His way within, God will give even 'a greater grace' namely all that follows from humbleness and from turning away from the world."

THE ENEMIES OF GRACE
TWO EXTREMES OF THE FLESH

HUMANISM-The exaltation of man's concepts- a sympathy for the works of the flesh

- 1.Licentiousness-def. unrestrained liberty,morality syn. lasciviousness, dissolute
 - a. Jude 1:4- " turn the grace of God into . . .
 - b. 1 Cor.5:9-12- Not to keep company
 - c. 1 Cor 6:9-20- Unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God
- 2.Steps of destruction-2Pet.2: 9-
 - a.vs. 10- lust of uncleanness-
 - b.presumptuous, self willed
 - c.vs.14-eyes full of adultery
 - d.trained in covetous practices
 - e.vs.18&19-through liscence bring others into bondage
 - f.vs.20- their end is worse than their evil beginnings- return to vomit
- 5.Immorality-Eph. 4:17-20
 - a.uncleanness&greediness
- 6.Idolatry-the golden calf
 - a.Ex32- b. Rom1:18-32 (9steps
 - b.Col.3:5 covetousness which is idolatry-def-"the inordinate desire for gain or possession"
 1. love of money
- 7.Utopian delusions-
 - a. communism
 - b. new world order etc.

- 2.Hypocrisy-"to play a part, pretend to be what one is not. Concealing true character. False appearance of true religion or morals. Counterfeiting religion.

 - b. Rom2:17-29-" he is a Jew who is one inwardly, and circumcision is that of the heart, in the Spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not from men but from God."

 - 3) The Spirit distributes gifts to each one as He wills-I Cot. 12.11
 - 4) Every good and perfect gift comes down from above-James 1:17

 - 6) The gifts differ according to the amount of grace given-Rom 12:6
 - 7) Humility is the key to the gifts glorifying Christ-Rom.12:3 a) the gifts of the spirit, yes! (a dream)

GRACE IN RELATIONSHIPS

1. Instructions to a disciple, Timothy-2 Tim.2:1-2

"You therefore, my son be strong in the **grace** that is in Christ Jesus. And the things you have heard among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also."

2. In Marriage-1 Pet.3:7

" Likewise you husbands, dwell with them with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the **grace of life**, that your prayers may not be hindered."

- a. Joint heirs of the grace
- b. Prayers not hindered

3. In Speech and Conduct.- Col.4:6

" Let your speech always be with **grace**, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one."

a. Eph.4:(29)-32 "Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart **grace** to the hearers."

1) Bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, evil speaking, malice-31

2) Busybody-

3) Kind, tenderhearted, forgiving-3

b. Heb.13:9-"Do not be carried away by all kinds of strange teachings. It is good for our hearts to be strengthened (established) by **grace**, not by ceremonial foods, which are of no value to those who eat them.

1) Col.3:16-. . ."singing with **grace** in your hearts to the Lord."
